THE FROST SAINTS or ICE MEN known in Czech as <u>*LEDOVI MUZI*</u> are Sts Mamertas, Servatius, Pancras, & Boniface of Tarsus whose feast days are May 12—14. Their intercession was invoked for crop planting protection from late spring frosts. This custom was associated with the Rogation & Ember Days, which were quarterly observances coinciding with the change of seasons. Rogation & Ember Days had fasting & abstinence as-well-as litanies & processions interceding for favorable agricultural weather. Rogation & Embers Days were sanctioned by Pope Gregory the Great in 598 AD. Rogation/Embers Days were discontinued after Vatican II.
