Jubilee Year Plenary Indulgence: Opportunities for yourself or a deceased loved one or poor souls will end on Epiphany Sunday 2026. Conditions are 1. Make the intention to receive this grace/indulgence, 2) Receive Holy Communion on the day, 3) Say the prayers for the indulgence and for the Holy Father (invoking Mary) and 4) Strive to have no attachment to any sin even venial. 5) Be in the state of grace on the day and go to confession within 20 days before or after.

Father will be out on Tuesday doing a funeral in Sutton and will move his day off leaving Thursday and returning Friday due the Monday Holy day. Thank you for your understanding.

"DURING THE ORDINARY JUBILEE OF 2025, all other Indulgences previously granted remain in force. All the faithful, who are: **1) truly repentant and free from any affection for sin** (cf. Enchiridion Indulgentiarum, IV ed., norm. 20, § 1), who are moved by a spirit of charity and who, during the Holy Year, **2) purified through the sacrament of penance (within 20 days)** and refreshed by **3) Holy Communion (on the day of the indulgence)**, **4) pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff**, WILL BE ABLE TO OBTAIN FROM THE TREASURY OF THE CHURCH A **PLENARY INDULGENCE, WITH REMISSION AND FORGIVENESS OF ALL THEIR SINS, WHICH CAN BE APPLIED IN SUFFRAGE TO THE SOULS IN PURGATORY** IN THE FOLLOWING WAYS: ... individually or in a group, they devoutly visit **ANY JUBILEE SITE** and there, for a suitable period of time, engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation, **concluding with the 1) OUR FATHER, 2)THE PROFESSION OF FAITH in any legitimate form, and 3) INVOCATIONS TO MARY, THE MOTHER OF GOD**, so that in this Holy Year everyone "will come to know the closeness of Mary, the most affectionate of mothers, who never abandons her children" (*Spes non confundit*, 24)." **DECREE ON THE GRANTING OF THE INDULGENCE DURING THE ORDINARY JUBILEE YEAR 2025 CALLED BY HIS HOLINESS POPE FRANCIS - 13 May 2024 (annotated)**

- 1) Be truly repentant and free from any affection for sin (mortal or venial)**
- 2) Be purified through the sacrament of penance (within 20 days)**
- 3) Holy Communion (on the day of the indulgence),**
- 4) Pray Apostles Creed, Our Father and Pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff (invoking Mary, Mother of God)**
