From the Bishop – At all Sunday Masses next weekend, Feb. 21 & 22 there will be a 2nd collection for disaster relief for the Archdiocese of Colombo in Sri Lanka. Sri Lanka experienced its most severe flooding in decades in late November and early December 2025 after Cyclone Ditwah brought prolonged heavy rainfall, which triggered landslides and widespread inundation across the country. This collection will provide financial assistance to the Archdiocese of Colombo to assist them in making repairs to Church property and to provide material assistance to those who are still struggling to rebuild. Any checks should be made out to “[name of local parish]” and put in an envelope marked for this second collection with your name. If you plan to give to this collection, please do so by March 1. If you give other than during the special 2nd collection, please be sure to label the plain envelope “Disaster Relief for Colombo.”

The Holy See has formally notified Bishop Louis Tylka of Peoria, Illinois, that the cause of the Venerable Servant of God Bishop Fulton Sheen may now proceed to beatification, clearing the way for the American prelate to be declared “Blessed” in the Catholic Church. For Catholics less familiar with the Church’s canonization process, beatification represents a pivotal moment. It acknowledges that a deceased person lived a life of heroic virtue and that a miracle has occurred through his or her intercession, allowing for public veneration, usually at a local or regional level. Canonization, which would follow at a later stage, would extend that veneration to the universal Church and would require the recognition of a second miracle after beatification.
