DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY – The Divine Mercy devotion is a modern devotion to the attribute of God's infinite mercy that was promulgated by St. Faustina Kowalska in Poland, and later by the Universal Church by St. Pope John Paul II in 2000. Jesus appeared to this simple Polish nun entrusting her with a special mission, to have His image painted (as he appeared to her) with the inscription, "Jesus I trust in you", and to spread devotion to His Divine Mercy. **Jesus said, "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment."** He also taught her the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and requested that it be said as a novena that would begin on Good Friday. Jesus said that through this novena a person would receive all the graces they need. All are encouraged to take a pamphlet located at the entrance of the church and on last weeks bulletin, to find out more.
